Absztrakt

Fear and rejection of migrants and foreigners is so widespread in some European countries that it can be seen as a socially shared norm, while in other countries acceptance of migrants and ethno-racial diversity is a widely-shared value. With the recent wave of mass migration, these dissimilarities in attitudes have moved to the forefront of public discussion, and there is consequently a need for a deeper understanding of cross-national differences. In order to contribute to this debate, our analysis aimed to investigate potential factors behind country-specific patterns of anti-migrant attitudes in European countries. The presentation will use data of the European Social Survey Round 7 and macro indicators of Eurostat and other European data sources.
