Abstract

Taking up criticisms of sociological research as over-focusing on the interview, this chapter considers what can be learned from looking beyond the interview in qualitative research and the implications for the study of ethnicity/'race'. The chapter draws on a case study from ethnographic research that shows how understandings of ethnic and racial categorisations shift when research approaches transcend 'the interview'.
